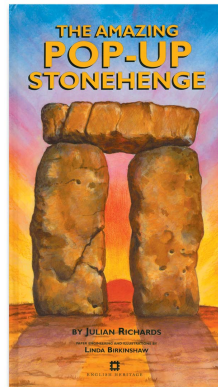




Experience Stonehenge

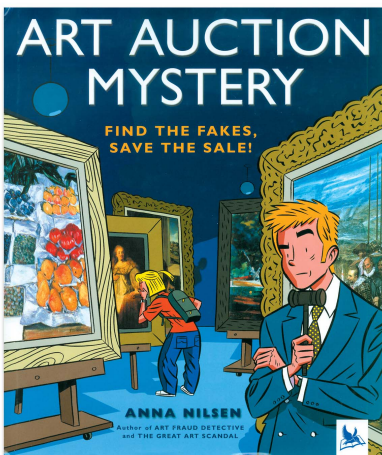
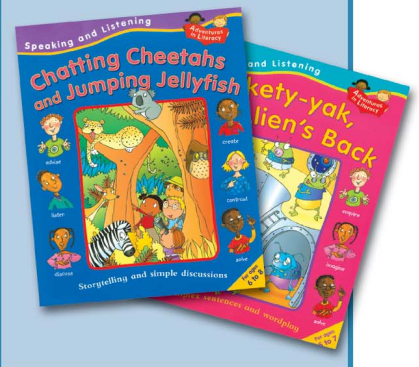
Adventures in Literacy

Fractions, decimals and percentages

They are ingenious and simple to use and can help pupils develop essential mathematical skills. By using the vertical channels, the children can fold the grid to discover that $\frac{1}{4}$ is the same as 25% and 0.25 etc. and by folding the grids again and again they can find the equivalent fractions, percentages and decimal values that make up 1.
